Guideline: Dress comfortably and wear sturdy shoes. After breakfast, follow your guide through Bursa's sites,


enjoy a cable car ride and views at Uludag, have lunch, and ensure you have all your belongings before returning to your hotel.




Day 6 - Full Day Cappadocia Red Tour with Lunch
