

BEST TOUR IN ISTANBUL & ANTALYA

Being a seaport, **Istanbul** is the fundamental exchange focus of **Turkey**. The **Bosphorus** associates the **Black Sea** and the Sea of Marmara and isolates **Europe** and **Asia**.

Antalya is a Turkish retreat city with a yacht-filled Old Harbor and shorelines flanked by enormous lodgings. It's a passage to Turkey's southern Mediterranean district, known as the Turquoise Coast for its **blue waters**.

Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrival in Istanbul

Meet at IST/SAW airport & transfer to your hotel. You will be given your room key and the rest of the day is yours to explore Istanbul. Overnight in Istanbul

Guideline: Take rest Proper, Because you have to go on tour tomorrow.

Day 2 - Ottoman Relics Tour

Guests will be picked up around 8:00am, and brought to the Sultanahmet district, the oldest, most historic part of the city. The first stop of the day will be the Hagia Sophia, as our tour guide explains the significance of this massive building that was once a Christian church, then a mosque, and now a museum. Afterward, we will pass the Hippodrome of Constantinople, where we will see the site's impressive obelisk, before reaching the Blue Mosque. We should be sure to take pictures of both the interior and exterior of this impressive building. Next, we will continue to the Grand Bazaar, a massive, bustling complex to find clothing, decorative furnishings, food, and more. On the way to the bazaar, we will see other historical monuments, like the Tomb of Sultan Ahmet I, the Firuz Aga Mosque, and the exterior of the Tomb of Mehmed II. After our visit to the Grand Bazaar, we will make a brief stop for lunch. In the afternoon, we will visit Topkapi Palace, the primary residence of the Ottoman sultans for nearly 400 years. Afterward, we will visit the Little Hagia Sophia, the final stop on the tour before guests are returned to their hotels.

Guideline: St. Sophia Museum is closed on Mondays, Topkapi Palace is closed on Tuesdays and The Grand Bazaar is closed on Sundays.

Day 3 - Bosphorus Tour and Shopping at Spice Market

Guests will be picked up at their hotel. We will first drive toward the Golden Horn, the waterway that feeds into the Bosphorus Strait and the Sea of Marmara. Our first stop will be the Spice Bazaar (also known as the Egyptian Bazaar). After this, we will embark on a boat tour of the Bosphorus, following the European shore until we reach the second bridge, where we will double-back along the Asian shore. Once we have returned to land, we will eat lunch at a local restaurant. Afterward, we will cross the strait to visit Camlica Hill for an unforgettable view of the city, where we will spend some free time. Guests will then be returned to their hotel around 5:00pm.

Guideline: The Spice Bazaar is closed on Sunday, and will be replaced with the Pierre Loti Cafe.

Day 4 - Flight to Antalya

After breakfast, free time until you will be transferred to airport to catch flight to Antalya. Arrive & transfer to hotel.

Guideline: Take a proper rest in hotel because you have to go tomorrow on waterfall.

Day 5 - Antalya City & Water-falls

After the breakfast, you will be picked up from your hotel at around 09:30 for the tour of Antalya Waterfalls. Düden Waterfalls are a group of waterfalls in the province of Antalya. The waterfalls, formed by the Düden River (one of the major rivers in Southern Anatolia), are located 12km North east of Antalya. They end where the waters of the Lower Düden Falls drop off a rocky cliff directly into the Mediterranean sea. We will stop for lunch here which is included in the price. After the waterfalls we will drive to the old city centre of Antalya where you will have a couple of hours free time to explore the Harbour, go on a one hour boat tour (price not included) and indulge in the local shops! After tour, transfer back to your hotel.

Guideline: Take rest you have to go on tomorrow Pamukkale.

Day 6 - Pamukkale - Antalya

You will be picked up from your hotel at around 08:00 for the tour of Pamukkale, which is the center of natural thermal spring waters with healing properties. Due to the chemical properties in the water, pure white colored travertines and stepped water terraces have been created on the mountain slope. It is for its resemblance to cotton piles that it is called "Cotton Castle" in Turkish. Upon arrival, you will visit the travertines and the ancient city of Hierapolis which has the biggest Necropolis with 1200 gravestones in Anatolia. Also, the Sacred Pool is one of the highlights of the site (entrance is 35 TL per person extra self-payment). There shallow thermal waters ripple over a wonderful scattering of ancient Roman ruins that lie beneath. After tour, transfer back to Antalya hotel.

Guideline: Pack your luggage at night.

Day 7 - End Of Tour

After breakfast you will have free time until we depart to airport for our domestic flight to Istanbul and then switch to international terminal to catch home-bound flight. Child Policy

Discounted Deals:

The following child **discounts** apply to our all [Turkey packages](#). The below discounts apply when sharing accommodations with two adults. To receive the child discount, the age of the child must qualify at the commencement of services.

Age :

- If your kid is between 0-2 Years Child Free of charge.
- If your kid is between 3-6 Years Child receives a **50% discount** on the tour package price.
- If your kid is above 7 and below 11 then Child receives a **25%** discount on the tour package price.
- But on the other side, if your kid is above 11 like 12 Years then you have to Pays full.
- For kids, 0-2 years will get a baby cot in the room by request at the hotel reception. In case of non-availability of baby, cot child has to share existing bed with parents.

Kid's Accommodation:

- For children, 3-6 years will share the existing bed with parents.
- For children 7-11 years an extra mattress will be prearranged in parent's room.
- For children 12 years an extra mattress will be prearranged in the parent's room.

Travellers who are under **18** years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult throughout the tour, and are requested to share an adult's accommodation.

Note: (Prices are EXCLUDING 11-15 AUGUST 2019)
