Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrival in Istanbul

Meet at IST/SAW Airport & transfer to your hotel. You will be given your room key and the rest of the day is yours to explore Istanbul. Overnight in Istanbul.

Guideline: Take rest Proper, Because you have to go on tour tomorrow.

Day 2 - Istanbul Old City

Guests will be picked up around 8:00am, and brought to the Sultanahmet district, the oldest, most historic part of the city. The first stop of the day will be the Hagia Sophia, as our tour guide explains the significance of this massive building that was once a Christian church, then a mosque, and now a museum. Afterward, we will pass the Hippodrome of Constantinople, where we will see the site's impressive obelisk, before reaching the Blue Mosque. We should be sure to take pictures of both the interior and exterior of this impressive building. Next, we will continue to the Grand Bazaar, a massive, bustling complex to find clothing, decorative furnishings, food, and more. On the way to the bazaar, we will see other historical monuments, like the Tomb of Sultan Ahmet I, the Firuz Aga Mosque, and the exterior of the Tomb of Mehmed II. After our visit to the Grand Bazaar, we will make a brief stop for lunch. In the afternoon, we will visit Topkapi Palace, the primary residence of the Ottoman sultans for nearly 400 years. Afterward, we will visit the Little Hagia Sophia, the final stop on the tour before guests are returned to their hotels.

Guideline: St. Sophia Museum is closed on Mondays, Topkapi Palace is closed on Tuesdays and The Grand Bazaar is closed on Sundays.

An impressive day will start with Dervent valley.

Guests of this half-day tour can choose the morning or afternoon option, and will be picked up from their hotel at the selected time. We will first visit the Spice Bazaar, one of the city's most colorful and bustling attractions, which has been in operation since the 17th century and still remains a very popular attraction for locals and visitors alike. The tour guide will give us tips on the best stalls and kiosks to visit so we do not become overwhelmed by the busy market, where we will have roughly 45 minutes of free time to explore and shop. Next, we will head to the shores of the Bosphorus Strait for a cruise, learning about this important, strategic waterway that straddles the Asian and European continents. On our voyage, we will see an impressive showcase of many historic Istanbul buildings: the decadent façade of Dolmabahce Palace; 15th-century fortress Rumelihisari; the Beylerbeyi Palace, the summer home of Ottoman sultans; and many more. After tour, you will be transferred to ISL (NEW) Airport to catch flight to Cappadocia. Arrive & transfer to hotel.

Guideline: Take rest Proper, Because you have to go on North Cappadocia tomorrow.

Day 5 - Cappadocia to Kusadasi

After breakfast you will have free time until we depart to airport for our domestic flight to Izmir. Arrive & transfer to Kusadasi Hotel. Enjoy the free day for leisure in Kusadasi.

Guideline: Take rest Proper, Because you have to explore more places tomorrow.

Then we keep going on with Pasabag "fairy chimneys", where you can feel the mystic of Fairy Chimneys. We will break at Avanos center of terracotta art. Ceramic dated back to the 3000 BC in the area and survived from to generations A visit to ceramic & tile center to see how the ceramics made by hand. After lunch we visit the famous Goreme Open Air Museum to see the best examples of Icons in Cappadocia. Soft rocks of Cappadocia from the clefts carved out to form such as stables, churches, monasteries. A visit to the carpet weaving co-operation to see how the Turkish carpet made by hand. We will enjoy the day by taking a look to the Goreme Valley from next to the Uchisar Rock-Castle. After tour, transfer back to hotel.

Day 6 - Ephesus Tour - Kusadasi

Tour start from the port of Kusadasi proceed to the House of the Virgin Mary includes scenic views of the Byzantine fortress in Selcuk and the Temple of Artemis. A long and winding road affords wonderful views of the valley en route to the Shrine of St. Mary. The diminutive house, beautifully situated in the Solmissos Mountains, is considered by the Vatican to be the final resting place of the Virgin Mary. Your tour continues to ancient Ephesus, where you'll pass through the arched Magnesia Gate and begin a slow, downhill walk to the ruins of the Roman provincial capital. Your knowledgeable guide will highlight such sights as the beautifully preserved Temple of Hadrian, the magnificent Trajan Fountain, the

Odeon Theater, once used for both political and entertainment purposes, and the beautiful Celsus Library with its imposing façade and two story Corinthian-style columns. The dramatic Great Theater is one of the few structures still used today. It seats twenty-five thousand and, although it was once an arena for gladiator games, it is now home to annual spring festivals. Temple Of Artemis (Diana), on the side of one of the seven wonders of ancient World. After tour, transfer back to hotel.

Guideline: Take rest Proper, Because you have to explore more places tomorrow.

Day 7 - Pamukkale Tour - Kusadasi

You will be picked up from your hotel at around 08:00 for the tour of Pamukkale, which is the center of natural thermal spring waters with healing properties. Due to the chemical properties in the water, pure white colored travertines and stepped water terraces have been created on the mountain slope. It is for its resemblance to cotton piles that it is called "Cotton Castle" in Turkish. Upon arrival, you will visit the travertines and the ancient city of Hierapolis which has the biggest Necropolis with 1200 gravestones in Anatolia. Also, the Sacred Pool is one of the highlights of the site (entrance is 35 TL per person extra self-payment). There shallow thermal waters ripple over a wonderful scattering of ancient roman ruins that lie beneath. After tour, transfer back to hotel.

Guideline: Pack your luggage because you need to leave tomorrow.

Discounted Deals:

The following child **discounts** apply to our all [Turkey packages](#). The below discounts apply when sharing accommodations with two adults. To receive the child discount, the age of the child must qualify at the commencement of services.

Age :

- If your kid is between 0-2 Years Child Free of charge.
- If your kid is between 3-6 Years Child receives a **50% discount** on the tour package price.
- If your kid is above 7 and below 11 then Child receives a **25%** discount on the tour package price.
- But on the other side, if your kid is above 11 like 12 Years then you have to Pays full.
- For kids, 0-2 years will get a baby cot in the room by request at the hotel reception. In case of non-availability of baby, cot child has to share existing bed with parents.

Kid's Accommodation:

- For children, **3-6** years will share the existing bed with parents.
- For children **7-11** years an extra mattress will be prearranged in parent's room.
- For children **12** years an extra mattress will be prearranged in the parent's room.

Travellers who are under **18** years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult throughout the tour, and are requested to share an adult's accommodation.
